

Dr. Solafa Goueli

Professional Biography



Dr. Solafa Goueli is the Executive Director of the National Training Academy (NTA) of Egypt, appointed by Presidential Decree in July 2025 and renewed for a second year starting July 2026. With over three decades of experience in education and higher education, institutional governance, and international cooperation, she has dedicated her career to building strategic partnerships between academic institutions, government entities, and international organizations to advance human capital development across Egypt.



Dr. Goueli served as CEO of the Nile International Education System (NIES) Unit at the Education Development Fund under the Egyptian Cabinet of Ministers (2015–2022), where she achieved international recognition for the NIES Secondary Certificate, was responsible for the Nile Egyptian Schools, and established NIES as an examination board through sustained collaboration with Cambridge International Education. She also served as Academic Provost and General Secretary of Badya University (2024–2025), overseeing institutional administration and policy development.

Since 2021, Dr. Goueli has also served as Director of Academic Development and International Relations at Taaleem Management Services, supporting QS ranking processes for Nahda University in Beni Suef, finalizing the university's strategic plan, and fostering international academic partnerships.

Earlier in her career, Dr. Goueli served as an Accreditation Specialist with the USAID-funded Education Reform Program, leading professional development workshops for 20 faculties across Egyptian universities and building institutional capacity for quality assurance and accreditation.

She also served as Deputy Project Director for Training and Professional Development at the Nile Egyptian Schools Project, where she designed and implemented extensive teacher training programs in collaboration with Cambridge International Examinations.
